

Gospel Community Study Questions

The Lord's Supper | (Luke 22:14-20)

Key Passage: Luke 22:14-20

Big Idea: Jesus welcomes those that he loves to remember and receive his love, peace and hope as he feeds us by faith at the Lord's Supper.

Discuss

What things stood out most for you from the sermon we heard on the Lord's Supper on Sunday?

Read

Read Luke 22:14-20, Matthew 26:26-29, Mark 14:22-25 and 1 Corinthians 11:17-34.

Share what we learn about the Lord's Supper from these verses. Here are some questions that may be helpful to consider as you listen to each passage:

- What are the key words in this passage?
- · Are any words or thoughts repeated?
- · Are there any commands?
- How do we understand the gospel better from this passage?

We read that Jesus celebrated this meal with his disciples during the Passover celebration. What did this meal mean for God's people and how does Jesus give new meaning to it as he shares this supper with his disciples?

In the passages we read, what are the essential components involved in the Lord's Supper and what is the significance of each of them?

We heard on Sunday how this simple meal is given to us by God to strengthen our faith as we look back to the finished work of the cross and we look forward to Jesus to making all things new. Spend some time sharing how the Lord's supper has encouraged you in your faith.

Pray

The Lords Supper is a powerful demonstration of our union with God *and* our union with each other. Spend some time in prayer giving thanks to God for both.
