IDENTITY | Transformation

Key Passages: 2 Corinthians 3:1-18; Acts 4:13

Big Idea: *We're committed to pursue transformation in our lives and others*

Read

Read 2 Corinthians 3:1-18; Acts 4:13

Discuss

What things stood out most for you from the sermon we heard on our value of 'transformation' on Sunday? Share where you found comfort, encouragement or challenge.

The foundational and primary area of transformation we looked at on Sunday was the Spirit transforming us to be more like Christ by his power (what the bible calls sanctification). Reflect together on how the Spirit changes us as believers - don't worry about going too deep 'theologically', simply think 'what difference has the Holy Spirit made in my life?'

Spend some time worshiping the Lord in prayer in response to what you've shared.

From the passage in 2 Corinthians 3 (particularly verse 18), discuss together:

- What we're being transformed into as disciples of Christ
- How we're being transformed into disciples of Christ

We shared on Sunday the importance of the "all" at the start of verse 18. Why is the community aspect of our sanctification so important and in what ways do you see this being worked out in practice?

Close your time praying for each other that we'd see true transformation in our lives and others at Liberti Church.
