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IDENTITY | Presence

*Key Passages: Matthew 28:16-20; Proverbs 16:9; Psalm 37:23; Romans 1:16*

**Big Idea:** *We will enjoy and practice a tangible presence in our community through Word & deed*

### Read

Read Matthew 28:16-20

### Discuss

Start with discussing what comes to mind when you think of being “tangibly present” as a church community.

In Matthew 28, we read Jesus’ last instruction to His disciples. What do you understand “making disciples” to involve? How does the bible help us understand what this looks like in practice? Take time to share as well how you have been discipled in your own faith journey.

Matthew 28 helps us see that making disciples is the central purpose of our life. Share and reflect honestly the implications of this truth for you.

The passages in Proverbs and Psalms help us to see that the Lord has sovereignly placed us where we are. How might this help us step into the command to make disciples with a greater intentionality?

We talked on Sunday how it is the Gospel word that is the power for salvation (Romans 1:16). What does this teach us about how we might see our community transformed?

What deeds that point to Jesus might we engage in in the places that God has sovereignly placed us?

### Pray

Close your time praying for each other that we’d see the Lord save many through our words and deeds in the months to come.
