Virtues | Feminine Virtue

Key Passages:

Big Idea: *The Gospel gives us a family with sisters who have strength that flows from gospel wisdom & is seen in gospel welcome*

Read

Read Genesis 1:27-31

Discuss

Having read Genesis 1:27-31, how does this passage affirm the inherent equality and dignity between men and women and push against both worldly misogyny and sinful, hierarchical views that suggest women have less value than men? In what ways can the church explicitly and subtly deny the equal value of men and women?

What are the unique ways in which you see women reflecting the image of God? How can we celebrate these and what ways do we/can we ensure that these gifts and characteristics are used well at Liberti?

God saw all that He had made, including the distinction between male and female, and called it "very good" (1:31). How does this combat modern ideologies that view gender as fluid, arbitrary, or a social construct?

Before the Fall, the man and woman are depicted serving together under God's sovereignty. How does this "very good" original design challenge cultural views that might see femininity as passive or inferior?

For the women, what area of your life is it most difficult to trust that God's design for your femininity is "very good," and how can the truth of Genesis 1:27 bring comfort?

Give plenty of time to give thanks for the women in your GC and pray that they would continue to flourish in the beautiful design that God has made them in. Pray for the men as they prepare to gather this coming weekend.
